Happy 2022! We hope that your families are adjusting well to life at home and enjoyed the holiday season. We now have a total of 50 enrolled infants (including 5 sets of twins)! In the year 2021, we made a lot of progress:

- Enrolled 35 new infants in Nourish
- Saw families at more than 50 follow up visits
- Performed 25 MRIs
- Completed 84 sets of anthropometric measures
- Performed 36 Pea Pods and 62 BIA measures
